March — Atonement

## March 1 — The Holy Diagnosis

Scripture: Romans 3:23

For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;

Atonement begins with diagnosis. Scripture does not flatter humanity—it tells the truth. All have sinned. This is not merely a behavioral misstep but a spiritual fracture. The cross makes sense only when we understand the depth of the disease.

Prayer: Lord, anchor me in the finished work of Christ. Let me live from grace today. Amen.

## March 2 — The Silence Between Us

Scripture: Isaiah 59:2

But your iniquities have separated between you and your God, and your sins have hid his face from you, that he will not hear.

Sin creates relational silence. It clouds prayer and numbs worship. Atonement is God's refusal to leave that silence unanswered.

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## March 3 — A New Heart

Scripture: Psalm 51:10

Create in me a clean heart, O God; and renew a right spirit within me.

David does not ask for editing—he asks for transformation. Atonement is not behavior modification; it is heart renewal.

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## March 4 — Blood Speaks

Scripture: Hebrews 9:22

And almost all things are by the law purged with blood; and without shedding of blood is no remission.

In Scripture, blood represents life. The shedding of blood reveals that life must be given to restore what sin has damaged.

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## March 5 — Provided Lamb

Scripture: John 1:29

The next day John seeth Jesus coming unto him, and saith, Behold the Lamb of God, which taketh away the sin of the world.

God provided what humanity could not. Redemption is not human invention; it is divine initiative.

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## March 6 — Wounds That Heal

Scripture: Isaiah 53:5

But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed.

His wounds do not merely expose suffering—they secure healing. Atonement turns violence into restoration.

Prayer: Lord, anchor me in the finished work of Christ. Let me live from grace today. Amen.

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## March 7 — The Great Exchange

Scripture: 2 Corinthians 5:21

For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him.

The innocent stood in for the guilty. The righteous bore the weight of rebellion. This exchange defines grace.

Prayer: Lord, anchor me in the finished work of Christ. Let me live from grace today. Amen.

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## March 8 — Justice and Mercy Meet

Scripture: Romans 3:26

To declare, I say, at this time his righteousness: that he might be just, and the justifier of him which believeth in Jesus.

God remains just while justifying sinners. The cross is where holiness and mercy embrace.

Prayer: Lord, anchor me in the finished work of Christ. Let me live from grace today. Amen.

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## March 9 — Love Demonstrated

Scripture: Romans 5:8

But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.

The cross is not abstract theology—it is love displayed in history.

Prayer: Lord, anchor me in the finished work of Christ. Let me live from grace today. Amen.

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## **March 10 — Once For All**

Scripture: Hebrews 10:14

For by one offering he hath perfected for ever them that are sanctified.

The sacrifice of Christ is complete. Redemption requires no additions.

Prayer: Lord, anchor me in the finished work of Christ. Let me live from grace today. Amen.

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## **March 11 — No Condemnation**

Scripture: Romans 8:1

There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.

Condemnation has no legal claim over those in Christ. The verdict has changed.

Prayer: Lord, anchor me in the finished work of Christ. Let me live from grace today. Amen.

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## **March 12 — Redeemed**

Scripture: Ephesians 1:7

In whom we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of his grace;

Redemption means release. What held us captive no longer defines us.

Prayer: Lord, anchor me in the finished work of Christ. Let me live from grace today. Amen.

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## **March 13 — Peace Restored**

Scripture: Colossians 1:20

And, having made peace through the blood of his cross, by him to reconcile all things unto himself; by him, I say, whether they be things in earth, or things in heaven.

Through the cross, hostility ends and peace is declared.

Prayer: Lord, anchor me in the finished work of Christ. Let me live from grace today. Amen.

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## **March 14 — Reconciled**

Scripture: 2 Corinthians 5:18

And all things are of God, who hath reconciled us to himself by Jesus Christ, and hath given to us the ministry of reconciliation;

Atonement restores relationship. We are welcomed back into communion.

Prayer: Lord, anchor me in the finished work of Christ. Let me live from grace today. Amen.

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## **March 15 — Bold Approach**

Scripture: Hebrews 4:16

Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need.

Because of Christ, we approach God confidently—not fearfully.

Prayer: Lord, anchor me in the finished work of Christ. Let me live from grace today. Amen.

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## **March 16 — Love Motivated**

Scripture: John 3:16

For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.

The motive behind atonement is not anger—it is love.

Prayer: Lord, anchor me in the finished work of Christ. Let me live from grace today. Amen.

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## **March 17 — Mercy's Fountain**

Scripture: Titus 3:5

Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to his mercy he saved us, by the washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Ghost;

Salvation flows from mercy, not merit.

Prayer: Lord, anchor me in the finished work of Christ. Let me live from grace today. Amen.

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## **March 18 — Adopted Children**

Scripture: Galatians 4:5

To redeem them that were under the law, that we might receive the adoption of sons.

Atonement moves us from outsiders to heirs.

Prayer: Lord, anchor me in the finished work of Christ. Let me live from grace today. Amen.

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## **March 19 — Abba Father**

Scripture: Romans 8:15

For ye have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear; but ye have received the Spirit of adoption, whereby we cry, Abba, Father.

The Spirit confirms our belonging.

Prayer: Lord, anchor me in the finished work of Christ. Let me live from grace today. Amen.

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## **March 20 — Made Alive**

Scripture: Ephesians 2:4-5

But God, who is rich in mercy, for his great love wherewith he loved us, Even when we were dead in sins, hath quickened us together with Christ, (by grace ye are saved;)

Grace resurrects what sin declared dead.

Prayer: Lord, anchor me in the finished work of Christ. Let me live from grace today. Amen.

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## **March 21 — Debt Cancelled**

Scripture: Colossians 2:14

Blotting out the handwriting of ordinances that was against us, which was contrary to us, and took it out of the way, nailing it to his cross;

The record against us has been nailed to the cross.

Prayer: Lord, anchor me in the finished work of Christ. Let me live from grace today. Amen.

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## **March 22 — Personal Shepherd**

Scripture: John 10:11

I am the good shepherd: the good shepherd giveth his life for the sheep.

The Shepherd's sacrifice is intentional and relational.

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## **March 23 — Interceding Savior**

Scripture: Hebrews 7:25

Wherefore he is able also to save them to the uttermost that come unto God by him, seeing he ever liveth to make intercession for them.

Redemption continues through Christ's advocacy.

Prayer: Lord, anchor me in the finished work of Christ. Let me live from grace today. Amen.

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## **March 24 — Cleansed Continually**

Scripture: 1 John 1:7

But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and the blood of Jesus Christ his Son cleanseth us from all sin.

The blood cleanses as we walk in light.

Prayer: Lord, anchor me in the finished work of Christ. Let me live from grace today. Amen.

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## **March 25 — Gift of Life**

Scripture: Romans 6:23

For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.

Eternal life is a gift, not earned wages.

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## **March 26 — Victory Given**

Scripture: 1 Corinthians 15:57

But thanks be to God, which giveth us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.

The cross leads to triumph.

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## **March 27 — Washed Identity**

Scripture: Revelation 1:5

Unto him that loved us, and washed us from our sins in his own blood,

We are cleansed and commissioned.

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## **March 28 — Removed Sin**

Scripture: Psalm 103:12

As far as the east is from the west, so far hath he removed our transgressions from us.

Sin is removed beyond retrieval.

Prayer: Lord, anchor me in the finished work of Christ. Let me live from grace today. Amen.

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## **March 29 — Completion Assured**

Scripture: Philippians 1:6

Being confident of this very thing, that he which hath begun a good work in you will perform it until the day of Jesus Christ:

The God who began redemption will finish it.

Prayer: Lord, anchor me in the finished work of Christ. Let me live from grace today. Amen.

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## **March 30 — Joy Beyond Suffering**

Scripture: Hebrews 12:2

Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our faith; who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God.

Christ endured the cross for joy—the joy of restored people.

Prayer: Lord, anchor me in the finished work of Christ. Let me live from grace today. Amen.

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## **March 31 — Worthy Lamb**

Scripture: Revelation 5:9

And they sung a new song, saying, Thou art worthy to take the book, and to open the seals thereof: for thou wast slain, and hast redeemed us to God by thy blood out of every kindred, and tongue, and people, and nation;

Redemption results in worship. The Lamb is worthy because He was slain.

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
